- Cereal
- Soup
- Pasta sauce
- Beans
- Tinned meat
- Tinned vegetables
- Tea/coffee
- Tinned fruit
- Biscuits
- Toiletries – deodorant, toilet paper, shower gel, shaving gel, shampoo, soap, toothbrushes, tooth paste, hand wipes
- Household items – laundry liquid detergent, laundry powder, washing up liquid
- Feminine products – sanitary towels and tampons
- Baby supplies – nappies, baby wipes and baby food. (NOT formula milk.)

## **6th July - Another Referendum!**

On Thursday 6th July the Highgate Neighbourhood Plan will go to referendum, all residents of the Holly Lodge Estate (with the exception of those living on Swain's Lane and who live in the Dartmouth Park Neighbourhood Forum boundary) are entitled to vote at the HLE Community Centre. It was developed by the Highgate Neighbourhood Forum (comprising representatives from various local amenity groups) over the last 4½ years, has now been reviewed and accepted by both Camden and Haringey councils, and can be found at [www.highgateneighbourhoodforum.org.uk](http://www.highgateneighbourhoodforum.org.uk)

The Plan's vision for Highgate is to be a vibrant place with a strong sense of community that protects its unique character and heritage while embracing fresh ideas and beneficial change. To this end it identifies 6 key policies;

- Social & Community – housing, community facilities, etc
- Economic activities – Highgate Village & Archway Road shopping centres & local employment
- Traffic & Transport – including parking, air quality, east-west Hoppa busses
- Open spaces & the public realm
- Development & Heritage – supporting the HLE CA appraisal
- Key development sites.

It is the first cross borough plan in the country. If passed it will rank on par with both Councils' local plans and a portion of any Community Infrastructure Levy will be awarded to the Forum to support local projects.

So add 6<sup>th</sup> July to your diary and vote for a better Highgate.
