Statement Holly Lodge Committee

Having lived full time on the Holly Lodge Estate since 1980, I greatly appreciate the benefits that living on the estate brings to its residents: a real sense of being part of a mixed community, the variety of trees and the large green open spaces, as well as quiet streets without through traffic.

I have been working as part of the committee to improve the estate for a number of years. During this time the parking attendant has joined our team and worked tirelessly to improve our living environment. He has made a huge difference to reducing parking infringements as well as reducing antisocial behaviour. His work is much appreciated.

I have particularly concentrated on working with the Estate Manager, Grounds Team and Tree and Gardens Subcommittees to maintain and improve the variety and quality of the trees on the estate. Additionally, I have worked to reinvigorate the gardens and planting including trialing various approaches to wilding. This year parts of the estate have been seeded with a mixture of annual and perennial seeds. Fingers crossed for a beautiful outcome!

Lastly, I worked to improve access for bikes on and off the estate by helping to design the modification of the gates at either end of Langbourne Ave. This has taken the bikes off the pavements and made it safer for pedestrians.

The estate is a thriving community and its needs are constantly changing. I would very much like to continue in my role on the committee, finding creative solutions to meeting these needs.
